



**Study Hub for All AHS Students.**  
**Information to Parents and Students.**

The aim of the Study Hub is to provide an opportunity for all students in Years 7 to 12 to access the facilities in the Library outside of normal school hours. This includes the computers and associated programs & printing, reference books, journals and so on. Students will also be able to borrow books. A book club and other interest groups will also meet during this dedicated Study Hub time.

Teaching staff will also be available to assist students with their homework and study requirements. **As teachers will be available on a volunteer basis** it is important for students to ensure they seek assistance from their class teachers with the details of specific homework and assignment requirements.

The school will also provide some refreshments for the students who attend the Homework Centre. Sandwiches and fruit are examples of food items that may be on the menu.

**The details are:**

**When** – Every Monday afternoon from 3.30 to 4.30pm; starting from the 21st of February 2022.

**Where** - The Library and other classrooms as arranged by specific teachers for specific study needs such as Visual Arts, Drama, Design & Technology, Science and Textiles.

**Requirements** – Students will need to register their interest in attending so I know that parents are aware of their child’s activities. Students can stay for as long as they like during the times the Study Hub is open and can come every week or when they have particular homework needs.


As this is a volunteer programme, student behaviour is expected to be exemplary. Students disrupting other students or teachers may be removed from the programme. Parents will be contacted but please note that in the decade long history of the HW Centre / Study Hub we have never had to contact parents for this reason.

**Travel** – Students and parents will need to organise transport home. Assistance may be available with transport home if negotiated with Ms Stewart-Hawkins.
